

2.0 SAFETY INFORMATION

2.1 USAGE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

3.0 TRAINING

3.1 TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

The employer of the operator is responsible for providing a training program sufficient for the safe operation of the unit.

3.2 TRAINING PROGRAM

The employer provided operator training program should cover safety procedures concerning use of the unit in and around the intended aircraft at the intended aircraft servicing location.

3.3 OPERATOR TRAINING

The operator training should provide the required training for safe operation of the unit.

NOTE: Maintenance and Trouble Shooting are to be performed by a skilled and trained technician.

4.0 OPERATION

4.1 WHEEL REMOVAL

- 1. Verify that the dolly lifting frame is close to the ground and nothing is stowed on it.
- 2. Maneuver dolly into position so that rollers straddle wheel.
- 3. When dolly is in place around wheel, raise lifting frame by operating the hydraulic jack until there is firm contact with tire. The release valve on the hydraulic jack must be closed to raise the lifting frame.
- 4. Remove wheel per aircraft manufacturer's instructions and secure the wheel to the dolly with the cargo tie down.
- 5. Operate the hydraulic jack to lift tire as necessary for transporting.

NOTE: To lower dolly, open release valve on the hydraulic jack. Rate of descent is proportionate to the amount of release valve opening.

Remove dolly from under aircraft.



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5.0 MAINTENANCE

Apply a light film of lubricating oil to hydraulic jack and all outer sliding surfaces. Wipe away excess oil with a clean, lint-free cloth.



8.0 GUARANTEES/LIMITATION OF LIABILITY


- ColumbusJACK Corporation, (Seller) warrants each new product of its manufacture to be free from defects in material
