1.0 **DESCRIPTION**

The Tronair Model K-4177 kit is designed for towing Saberliner Aircraft.

The towbar head attachment is designed for use with Tronair Multi-Head Towbar Model 01-1202-0000 for towing the previously stated aircraft. The towbar head attachment uses a sliding pin/stationary pin arrangement to interface with the aircraft tow point.

These excessive loads may cause failure of the towbar which could cause damage to the aircraft or personal injury.

- c) Replacement parts have a 90-day warranty from date of shipment




