

1.0 PRODUCT INFORMATION

1.1 DESCRIPTION

The Malabar Model PF56103-1PWS is a 2 gal (7.6 l) fluid dispenser used to service various aircraft. The hand pump dispenser consists of a reservoir, pump assembly, relief valve, water stop filter assembly, resettable fluid meter, pressure gauge and a fluid delivery hose with a coupling. The integral waste tank is graduated and has a vent, return house with a coupling, fluid sight and drain plug.

2.0 SAFETY INFORMATION



3.0 PREPARATION PRIOR TO FIRST USE

The Flush/Fill procedure outlined below is intended to flush any residual impurities out of the Engine, IPP and ESG Servicing Unit and to verify that fluid pumped from the Servicing Unit meets JSF Propulsion requirements for purity.

- 1. This service unit can be used with either MIL-PRF-7808 grade 4 or MIL-PRF- 23699 fluid. The fluid placard (figure 1A, item 11) is engraved on both sides. Remove the placard and reattach showing the appropriate fluid if necessary.
- 2. Remove fillport cap (figure 1B, item 1) and fill Serving Unit with two gallons of new MIL-PRF-7808 grade 4 fluid or two gallons of new MIL-PRF-23699 fluid. Replace fillport cap.
- 3. Remove the fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting (figure 1C, item 4) from fill hose in location as shown in figure below. Ensure there is no debris remaining at fitting interface and set QD aside to prevent contamination. Wipe down hose end with a lint free cloth as required.



- 4. Place Servicing Unit fill hose into a waste MIL-PRF-7808 grade 4 or MIL-PRF- 23699 fluid container without hose end touching side of container.
- 5. Empty MIL-PRF-7808 grade 4 fluid or MIL-PRF-23699 fluid from Servicing Unit by vigorously pumping handle until fluid tank is empty. Some residual fluid will remain in bottom of Servicing Unit.
- 6. Reassemble fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting onto fill hose. Torque hose onto QD at 40 in-lbs.
- 7. Wipe down dust plug (figure 1B, item 10) attached to Serving Unit carrying handle with a lint free cloth as required and install fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting onto dust plug. Return equipment to user.

4.0 TRAINING

4.1 TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

The employer of the operator is responsible for providing a training program sufficient for the safe operation of the unit.

4.2 TRAINING PROGRAM

The employer provided operator training program should cover safety procedures concerning use of the unit in and around the intended aircraft at the intended aircraft servicing location.

4.3 OPERATOR TRAINING

The operator training should provide the required training for safe operation of the unit.

NOTE: Maintenance and Trouble Shooting are to be performed by a skilled and trained technician.

5.0 OPERATION

- 1. Remove fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting from dust plug and connect the fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting to the aircraft pressure service point.
- 2. Remove return hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting from dust plug and connect the return hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting to the aircraft overflow service point.
- 3. Use full steady pumping strokes when operating pump assembly during replenishing.
- 4. Disconnect the fill hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting and the return hose quick disconnect (QD) fitting from the aircraft service points, attach fittings to the dust plugs and store the unit in a dry, dust free location.



6.0 MAINTENANCE

6.1 SERVICING

The frequency of filter change depends on operating conditions. Generally, changes should be made every 3-4 months or sooner if more than normal resistance is felt on the pumping stroke at low pressure. Refer to item 10 in figure 3 to change element. Proper element must be installed, otherwise unit will not pump fluid.

NOTE: The relief valve should not be removed. The relief valve is set toby-pass oil back to the reservoir at 125 ± 10PSIG.

6.2 REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT

No definite time schedule can be established for the overhaul of the pump assembly for the replacementof the various moving parts. The number of times the pump assembly is operated materially affect the life of the working parts. The moving piston seal (item 6) and rod seal (item 11) are normally the first to wear. This is usually indicated by leakage of fluid past the piston or rod. It is advisable to change piston seal (item 6), rod seal (item 11) and gasket (item 16) immediately if leakage is discovered. A repair parts kit (P/N PF2-69PK) is available and recommended to keep on hand at your facility. Refer to Repair Parts Kit for the complete list of parts contained in the kit.


9.0 GUARANTEES/LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- I. Seller warrants each new product of its manufacture to be free from defects in material or workmanship, under proper, reasonable, and normal use and service.
- II. The warranty period shall be as follows:
 - A. For Malabar equipment, with the exception of Tripod Jacks, the warranty period is one (1) year after date of shipment.
 - B. For Malabar Tripod Jacks, the warranty period is three (3) years after date of shipment.
- III. Where Buyer claims an alleged defect in material or workmanship and so advises Seller in writing within ten (10) days after discovery thereof, then and in such event, Buyer shall return said equipment, transportation prepaid, to the Seller, provided such return is timely and within the above-mentioned warranty period. This warranty and liability of the Seller is expressly limited solely to replacement or repair of defective parts or goods, and return at Buyer's expense to Buyer after finding by Seller the product was defective prior to original shipment or, at the option of Seller, to providing refund to Buyer of the purchase price for said product.






